The pigments listed below are consistent with Stephen Quiller's spectral breakdown of the color wheel into a list of 12 distinct colors (comprised of primaries, secondaries, and tertiaries). For an edited list (to cut back on cost) please refer to the two recommended LIMITED PALETTES below. I highly recommend investing in the twelve pigments listed immediately below, but if you decide to use one of the two LIMITED PALETTES suggested, you will also need Titanium White \& Ivory black.

## CANVAS/SURFACE

## YOUR CHOICE

- Primed linen that can be taped on board
- Primed linen pre-mounted on board
- Arches Oil Paper sheets $-16^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}(30 \times 40 \mathrm{~cm})$ [works even better if primed with one layer of diluted gesso]
- Gessoed paper (directions for preparing the paper - below)


## PREPPING GESSOED PAPER

If you decide to use gessoed paper, prepare larger sheets of paper (Strathmore 500 series 3-ply cotton rag-or museum mounting board-or equivalent). These can be cut down to various sizes.

Use two layers of gesso on the back (to prevent buckling) and three on the front side, painted as flatly as possible. I use a smooth foam molding roller. I typically dilute the gesso with water to the consistency of honey. Don't forget to mark the backs of the surfaces.

Please do not use cheap canvas board. They are too absorbent. The paint should be able to move a bit on the surface. However, the surface should not be too slick.
